Recreation and Education for Kids volunteer positions

If you would like to volunteer your services and time with the Vernon Parks and Recreation Department R.E.K. after school program, applications will be accepted starting on October 3rd. Volunteers must be currently in 10th grade or above. Any volunteer 18 years old and up must submit to a background check.

The R.E.K. after school program is for Vernon students enrolled in Kindergarten through fifth grade. We strive to provide a variety of fun, engaging indoor and outdoor activities to help kids learn, make friends, and have fun after school. R.E.K.

Volunteers will be paired with an R.E.K. Counselor and provide homework help, play games and gain future job experience. Volunteers interested in spending time with the R.E.K. after school program should complete the included application and return it to the Vernon Parks and Recreation Department during one of the two application windows. If selected into the program, volunteers will go through an on-boarding and training process. Students must complete the entire volunteer schedule for approval of volunteer hours. Volunteers' must be able to commit to at least one but no more than two days per week. Typical hours will be 2:45pm-6:00pm.

Winter Volunteers

Applications are accepted during the first two weeks of October with interviews to follow. The winter schedule is November through January.

Spring Volunteers

Applications are accepted during the first two weeks of February with interviews to follow. The Spring schedule is March through May.
