## • Trail Manager

Maintains a section of trail (1 – 2 miles) by removing trash and performing minor trail maintenance as well as monitoring the trail conditions. VGV, Inc. Board members regularly communicate with the town of Vernon Parks and Recreation department based on condition reports from the Trail Managers.

### Trail Maintenance Team

Meets weekly during the summer to repair the rail trail to combat erosion with stone dust provided by the town of Vernon.

### • Trail Blazer

Keeps the hiking trails clear of debris and plant encroachment.

### • Trail Gardener

Maintains gardens at rail trail entrances. In the spring volunteers work in teams to prepare the gardens for summer planting. Throughout the summer volunteers take care of these gardens and, in the fall, prepare the flower beds for winter.

### <u>Historical Significance</u>

The Lyman Brothers Dairy Farm – one of the last dairy farms in Vernon - operated on this property between 1896 – 1980.

The Talcott family – descendants of Governor Joseph Talcott (1725) - owned the property along the river in the early and mid-1800s.

Remains of a small mill dam can be seen in the river.


### **Walking Trail**

Stone Dust – Pavement – Boardwalk

### **Hiking Trail**

Follow Orange blazes in the woods and on 3 loops along the river between 0.25 mile and 0.5 mile.

Trail is wet at certain times of year – especially in the Spring and after heavy rainfall.



## HOCKANUM RIVER TRAIL

- North of Dart Hill Road

  Purple map provides Northern direction details.
- Parking for North Trailhead located at 775 Dart Hill Road opposite Worcester Road <u>OR</u> at 100 Windsorville Road (Rt. 74) Vernon Water Treatment Plant entrance.
- Orange blazes mark the trail along river.
- ◆ Entire trail: 3 miles between Pleasant View Dr.(south) and Windsorville Road / Route 74 (north).

### **Hockanum River Trail**

(North and South of Dart Hill Road)
